APRIL 1, 2026

The members present at the membership meeting held on Wednesday, April 1, 2026 voted and carried the following:

- Voted to pay an additional 100 hours of lost time in April 2026 for union officers and members to conduct union business.
- Voted to sponsor at the Bronze Level \$150 in support of the George Washington High School Car Show Event April 11.
- Voted to send two (2) Local 1782 members as delegates to the 2026 Legislative Conference held in Washington, D.C. June 21-25 paying for lost time, four (4) nights hotel, travel per diem, registration fees (if applicable) and least expensive transportation to/from the airport at a cost not to exceed \$3500 per person.
- Voted to send two (2) Local 1782 District 142 members to the Women's & Human Rights Summit June 2-5 paying for lost time, travel per diem, four (4) nights hotel, least expensive transportation to/from the airport and registration fees (if applicable) at a cost not to exceed \$2600 per person.
- Voted to purchase a quarter page ad for the TCU-IAM Convention at a cost of \$500.
- Voted to purchase a customized Local 1782 banner at a cost not to exceed \$250.
- Voted to send six (6) Local 1782 members as delegates to the 2026 District 141 Convention Oct 26-29 paying for lost time, three (3) nights hotel, registration fees and \$280 towards parking with a cost not to exceed \$2800 per person.
- Voted to purchase two (2) file cabinets and office supplies for the SMF United Union Office not to exceed \$550.

- Voted to reimburse President France Finau, Chair of the Trial Committee, the \$2200 deposit for the Court Reporting Stenographer of the Article L Trial set for April 6, 2026.
- Voted to conduct MNPL Station Visits in April covering mileage, parking, travel per diem, four (4) hotel rooms for one (1) night in SMF not to exceed \$4500.
- Voted to reimburse Lori DeLeon \$140.01 for District 141 Shop Steward Training notebooks and USPS certified mail.
